Role of the registered officer

A registered officer can nominate the party's endorsed candidates in a federal election and appoint deputy registered officers to do the same. The AEC sends all formal correspondence about the registration of the party to the registered officer.

An appointment takes a few days to be available to AEC Returning Officers throughout Australia, so any new appointment form should be lodged with the AEC well before the close of nominations in an election.

Note: An individual cannot hold the position of registered officer or deputy registered officer, for more than one federally registered political party.
