I am Norman and would like to comment on redistributions. As I am aware, a seat needs to be abolished to fit the new quota. You couldn't abolish any seat in the west given those areas are experiencing high growth, so will need to look at the seats in northern sydney. After reading a lot of the suggestions, it seems like abolishing Berowra makes the most sense. The seat of Wentworth would be good to extend southerly to include Randwick and Clovelly given its current low quota. Hughes can extend to the west to include liverpool as Ben Last s19 and Damien Ferri s40 has suggested. MacArthur should move westerly to include Camden and its surrounds as it better represents its historical and geographical regional boundaries. Hume can take in suburbs located to the south of Campbelltown. The other sydney seats would only need minor changes to accompany the shift in territory from Berowra to its surrounding seats. The seats in the regions should stay as regional seats and not extend into Sydney.
