To whom it may concern,

I wish to lodge my objection to the proposed New South Wales federal redistribution. My objection centres on the border of the Robertson and Dobell electorates in the suburb of Kulnura.

The proposed boundary keeps the existing boundary in Kulnura as George Downes Drive. This boundary has caused some consternation and confusion in Kulnura as it splits our small town in half.

The boundary of the two electorates has not always been George Downes Drive. Previously the entirety of Kulnura has all been contained in the one electorate.

The same issue arose previously when the State Electorates of Wyong and Gosford also used George Downes Drive as the boundary. This was corrected during the State redistribution in 2020-22 when the border of the Gosford electorate became the suburb border between Kulnura and Yarramalong and Cedar Brush Creek.

I ask that the Redistribution Committee no longer use George Downes Drive in Kulnura as the electorate boundary and instead use the suburb border between Kulnura and Yarramalong and Cedar Brush Creek as the boundary for the electorate. This has the benefit of bringing the whole community into one electorate and reduce confusion as it will be identical to the border used for State Electorates.

This would have the effect of ensuring Kulnura is contained fully within the electorate of Robertson.

It is my estimate that this will mean a transfer of some 100-200 people from the Dobell to Robertson electorate and will not have any adverse outcomes on enrolment projections.
