NSW Redistribution Objection

North Sydney

I urge the AEC to reconsider the decision to abolish the Federation electorate of North Sydney. The Lower North Shore has a distinctive identity and is a community of interest. The Greens have proposed abolishing Bradfield instead, which allows the name to be reassigned to Berowra, and Labor has suggested a merger between Hughes and Cunningham. Both of these options ought to be considered.

If the AEC does, in fact, decide to abolish North Sydney, I would urge the AEC to find a way to retain the name. "North Sydney" can be used to refer to a wider area and not just North Sydney LGA or CBD. Federation names ought to be preserved.
