Dear Redistribution Committee,

I write to object to the proposal to take northern areas from the division of Warringah, in particular North Curl Curl and the proposal to abolish the seat of North Sydney in the NSW federal redistribution.

Instead, I write in support of option A as set out in Suggestion 42 by Zali Steggall MP to maintain the northern boundaries of the Warringah electorate and minimise the impact on North Sydney by pushing the south/western boundaries of the division of Warringah to the Warringah Freeway only.

As a community member residing in North Curl Curl, I am concerned that the suggestions currently proposed are politically motivated and do not account for the projected increase in residents which will inevitably occur through currently proposed residential developments within the various electorates (including the significant developments currently under construction in Dee Why). The proposal also does not account that the catchment for Curl Curl North Public School (currently wholly within the Warringah electorate) which under the proposal will now be divided between the Mackellar and Warringah electorates. I would also note that the topography of North Curl Curl (outlook facing South) lends itself more to keeping it within the current boundaries than incorporating North Curl Curl into Mackeller.
