Dear Redistribution Committee,

I write to object to the draft plans to abolish the federal seat of North Sydney in the proposed 2024 NSW redistribution and instead I support:

I have been a resident of Manly/Queenscliff in the Federal seat of Warringah for 45 years and have developed deep connections to this beach-side community from Manly to Palm Beach.
