The Hon Andrew Gee MP Independent Federal Member for Calare Submission on the Proposed 2023-2024 New South Wales Federal Electorate Redistribution

Submission

- I refer to the Australian Electoral Commission's proposed redistribution of New South Wales released on 24 June 2024 ("the proposed redistribution").
- 2. I support the proposed redistribution as it pertains to the electoral division of Calare.
- 3. The proposed redistribution makes no changes to the boundaries of Calare. It is submitted that this is a sensible common sense proposal that is in the best interests of the communities of Calare for the reasons outlined in my submissions of 27 October 2023 and 10 November 2023 ("my previous submissions").
- In leaving the boundaries of Calare unchanged, the result is an electorate that meets the AEC's quotas and retains the strong communities of interest between the communities comprising the electorate.
- 5. The proposed redistribution as it pertains to Calare is a practical and sensible outcome. It is further submitted that it has very strong community support.

Conclusion

For the reasons outlined above and in my previous submissions, it is submitted that the boundaries of Calare contained in the proposed redistribution (ie. no change) should become the final boundaries.
