I am writing to provide commentary on the proposed redistribution made by the Victorian redistribution committee.

Firstly, I commend the redistribution committee on maintaining the proposed electorate of Casey around the Yarra Ranges Council and retain the Council within its boundaries.

It is my view as the General Manager of a local bus service provider, that the decision by the redistribution committee to maintain the proposed Casey electorate within the Yarra Ranges and Yarra Valley is the correct decision.


