Being remote from home & in a location where technology does not afford the scope to respond more fully, please find my objection to the proposed elimination of Higgins. I have reviewed the City of Stonnnington's submission & fully support it. I will add, Higgins is a seat well represented in terms of delivery of economic, social & leadership value on a national basis. I also believe it is one where a constant tinkering of boundaries has occurred over the years that has probably led to it now being one of the smaller seats by population basis. I believe it is important to not only retain Higgins but to restore aspects of its boundaries to accurately represent its domain.

ITEM 8.7 – Australian Electoral Commission Redistribution Councillor Recommendation (Requested By Cr Koce)

That Council:

- NOTE the proposal by the Committee to abolish the federal electorate of Higgins.
- 2. NOTES that the proposed re-distribution:
 - Severely fragments local communities of interest represented by Local Government Authorities (LGAs), suburbs and localities.
 - Ignores major existing physical and geographical boundaries such as Freeways, arterial roads and waterways.
 - Fails to identify and align with economic and social groupings.
 - Erases deep historical and cultural connections between the Stonnington
 community and the Higgins electorate.
 - Gives rise to confusion and uncertainty among Stonnington residents who will be divided and dispersed among five (5) different Federal Electorates.
 - Fails to recognise the importance of the Higgins Electorate to the local identity of residents and its importance to their connection and ongoing engagement in the national democratic system.
- PUBLICISE to the Stonnington community that there is an opportunity for individuals and organisations to object to the redistribution if they wish to.
- 4. SUBMIT a written objection to the Victorian augmented Electoral Commission 6pm 28 June 2024 highlighting the inconsistency of the Stonnington Local Government Area (LGA) being split across five electorates.
